

Advantages of Having The Ipad in Class

- Promotes independent and group work
- Allows for immediate research and sharing within the group members
- Ensures that pupils are fully engaged with the use of their own device
- Minimize waiting time to complete one's part of their project
- Enables effective use of class time as teacher is able to monitor and advise accordingly

Limitations

- Students might not be able to access Safari / Youtube
- Some groups complete the learning activity faster than expected
- Certain Units more possibilities for exploration than others
